AIM / GOAL

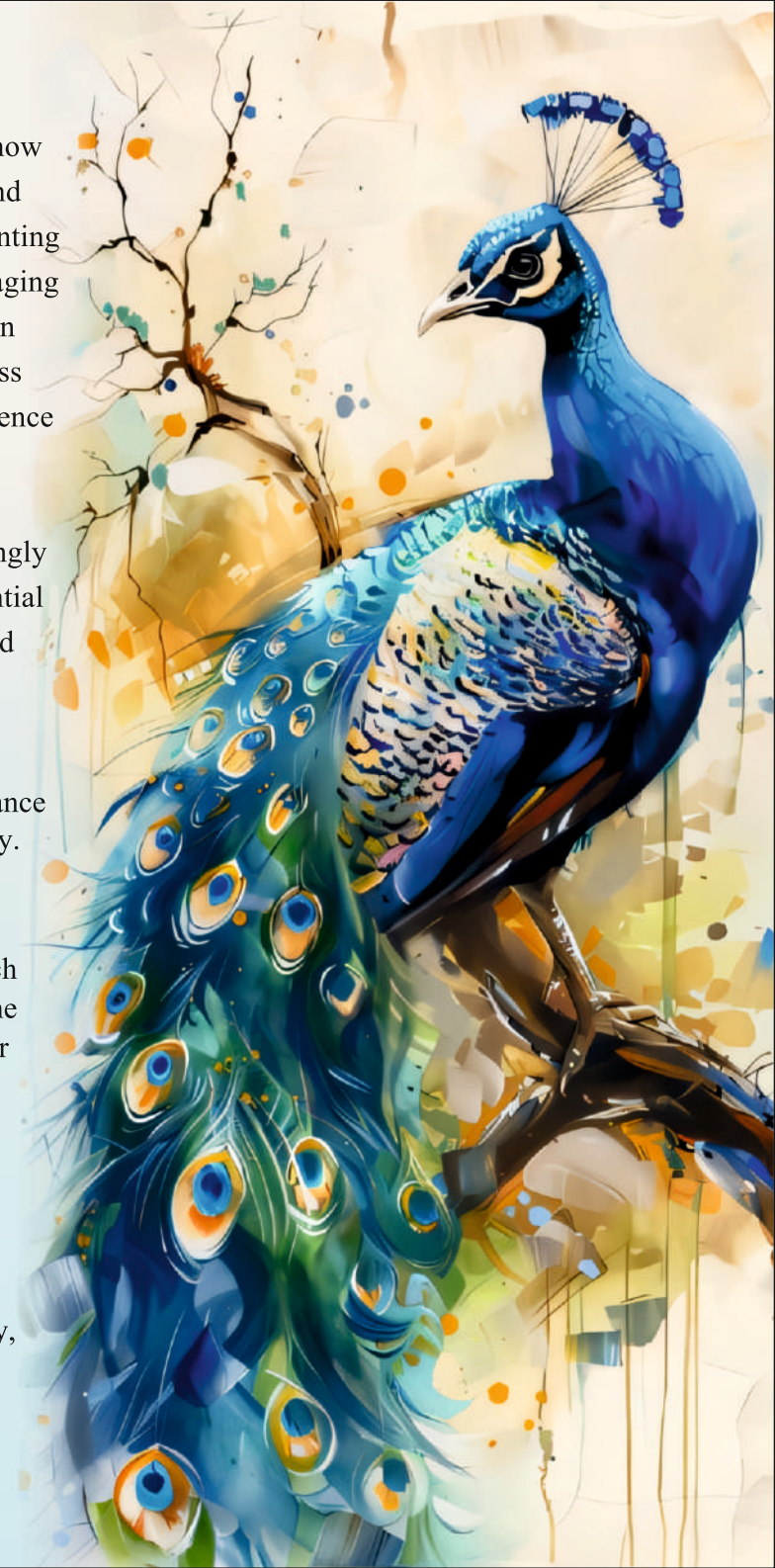

COMPETITION FOR COLOURING

For this competition, there are seven groups as listed below :

- Pre - Primary : (Nursery, Jr.KG & Sr.KG)
- Primary : (Std.1st & 2nd)
- Primary : (Std. 3rd & 4th)
- Primary & Secondary : (Std. 5th & 6th)
- Secondary : (Std. 7th & 8th)
- Secondary : (Std. 9th & 10th)
- Higher Sec. : (Std. 11th & 12th)

All of the colouring competition's images are enclosed. Student can use any colour.

COMPETITION FOR HANDWRITING

For this competition, there are three groups as listed below :

- Primary : (Nursery, Jr. KG & Sr. KG)
- Primary : (Std. 1st to 4th)
- Primary to Higher Sec. : (Std. 5th to 12th)

The poem or paragraph for the handwriting competition is enclosed. Students should write their paragraph or poem in the subsequent blank space.

COMPETITION FOR SKETCHING

For this competition, there is only one group as listed below :

- Primary to Higher Sec. : (Std. 1st & 12th)

Subjects for the sketching competition are enclosed. The choice of pen, pencil, and colour for shading and sketching is completely up to the students.

(Subjects are :- Historical Figure, Still Life, Freedom Fighters, Portrait)

COMPETITION FOR CARTOON MAKING

For this competition, there is only one group as listed below :

- Primary to Higher Sec. : (Std. 1st to 12th)

Students should draw and colour the cartoon on the blank page provided for cartoon making purpose. Participant student is free to choose any cartoon character as per their choice.

COMPETITION FOR COLLAGE

For this competition, there are two groups as listed below :

- Pre - Primary to Primary : (Nursery to 5th)
- Secondary to Higher Sec. : (Std. 6th to 12th)

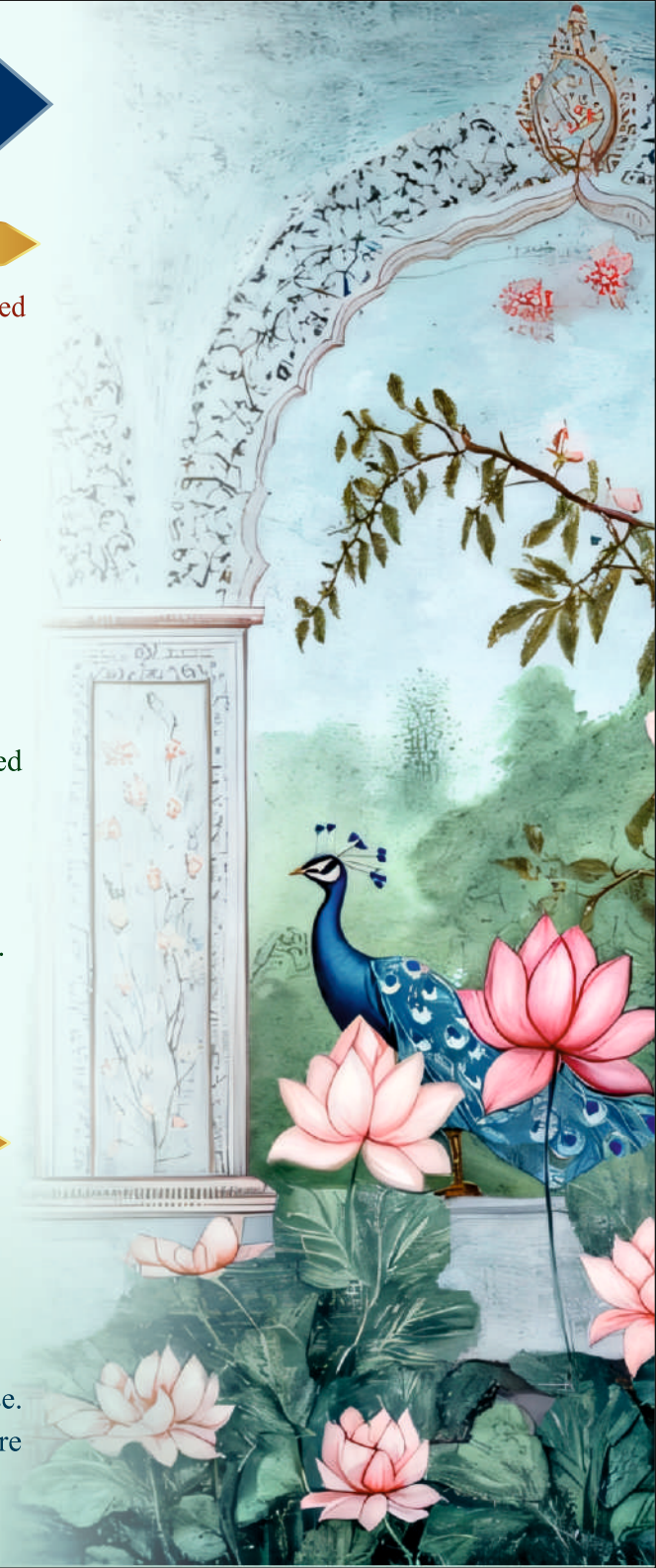
Pictures for the collage competition are enclosed. Students may make use of magazine paper, craft paper or any other type of creative material.

COMPETITION FOR CARICATURE

For this competition, there is only one group as listed below :

- Primary to Higher Sec : (Std. 1st to 12th)

Students should draw and colour the caricature on the blank page provided for caricature purpose. Participant student is free to choose any caricature character as per their choice.





COMPETITION FOR FINGER AND THUMB PAINTING

For this competition, there are six groups as listed below :

Pre-Primary	: (Nursery, Jr.KG & Sr.KG)
Primary	: (Std. 1st & 2nd)
Primary	: (Std. 3rd & 4th)
Primary & Secondary	: (Std. 5th to 7th)
Secondary	: (Std. 8th to 10th)
Higher Sec.	: (Std. 11th & 12th)

Paper provided for thumb painting, students can use water colours, objects like vegetables or thread. To make a coloured fingerprint, firmly press the piece of paper with your painted index finger.

COMPETITION FOR GREETING CARD

For this competition, there is only one group as listed below :

Primary to Higher Sec. : (Std. 1st to 12th)

Create a card using paper that is A4 in size. Students may use craft paper, cardboard paper, or other decorative items. On the back of the card, students are required to put their name and grade.

(Subjects are :- Women's Day, International Yoga Day, Thanking You, Appreciation, Festival.

(Select One of your choices.)

COMPETITION FOR TATTOO MAKING

For this competition, there is only one group as listed below :

Primary to Higher Sec. : (Std. 1st to 12th)

Picture for the tattoo making competition is enclosed. Students are free to use any colours and type of pen to draw the tattoo design.

COMPETITION FOR MASK MAKING

For this competition, there are three groups as listed below :

Primary	: (Std. 1st to 4th)
Primary to Secondary	: (Std. 5th to 10th)
Higher Sec.	: (Std. 11th & 12th)

Students may use craft paper, cardboard paper, colours, feathers or colorful cloth, handmade paper or other decorative items. Participant student is free to choose any mask as per their choice. Students are required to put their name and grade on the mask.

HOW WILL THE NATIONAL COMPETITION BE HELD AT YOUR SCHOOL ?

- After the art teacher has accepted and read the invitation, the students must be given details of the competition
- Please make sure that each student provides a copy of the relevant competition upon payment.
- For photocopying of the papers and courier services, the school will use 15% of the total sum.
- The remaining 85% of the funds must be transferred to us directly via NEFT to the organization's account, using a QR code, or through an online payment method.
- If payment is done via Demand Draft, ensure the Demand Draft is enclosed in the package that also contains the competition materials and entry form.
- Please include a copy of the bank receipt with the package if the money has been transferred to a bank account.
- Please give us the full breakdown of remittances.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. We humbly request the principal to recognize the dedicated efforts of your art teacher by paying the Rangotsav Celebration reward amount, as their hard work truly deserves acknowledgment.
2. You will receive one entry form. Please make a copy for your school. After the competition, send the entry copy along with your drawing papers in the parcel.
3. Please submit your entry only once. Subsequent submissions will be invalid.
4. Please pack the competition papers in plastic bags. Do not wrap them in paper, as it may cause misplacement.
5. Do not send any cash with the parcel. If the school includes cash and if misplaced, Rangotsav Celebration will not be responsible. You can make payments using a QR code, online payment methods, or NEFT only. Please adhere to this policy strictly.
6. The school will include the payment receipt and a list of student names with the parcel.
7. Please deduct 15% from the student entry fees. If you do not deduct this amount, we will not refund or pay back you the 15%.
8. Please note that schools will not cover any student fees for event directors. If your school pays these fees directly to an event director, the student's paper entry form will be considered invalid for the Rangotsav celebration. Instead, please make payments directly to the Rangotsav Celebration Bank Account.
9. Please do not give the contact numbers of the Rangotsav celebration to the parents.

EASY WAY TO PRINT STUDENT'S CERTIFICATE WITH NAME :

- Step 1.** Please visit our website at www.rangotsavcelebration.com and navigate to the national page.
- Step 2.** Click to upload student list for certificate in details.
- Step 3.** Then provide your school information and watch the instructional video on the left.
- Step 4.** To download the Excel format, please click on the download sample button provided below. This will give you a sample point. Make your excel file as it is. For example: 1. sr. no., 2.student name, 3. std, 4. school name, 5. competition name. (If any student participates in more than three competitions, please write their name three times)
- Step 5.** Please select the file containing the list of student names, and then proceed to upload it.
- Step 6.** After doing proper upload you will get thank you massage.
- Step 7.** If Student list is not uploaded properly you will get the blank certificate. (mails & WhatsApp will not be acceptable).
- Step 8.** Please make sure to upload the list of student names before sending the parcel to Rangotsav Celebration. This is an essential requirement for us. If you fail to upload the student list, we will not be able to begin the checking process until you provide us with the student name list. As a result, your results may be delayed. (Note : Just ignore this info if you want a blank certificate.)



RULES AND REGULATIONS

• The last date for submitting the competition entry forms and papers is September 10th, 2025. Late entries will be accepted until October 10th, 2025. No entry forms and papers will be accepted after October 11th, 2025.

- It is necessary to fill out the entry form with accurate information. Please make sure all the details you provide are correct and up-to-date. (The entry form will not be regarded as valid if it is not received with the parcel.)
- Please ensure that the list of participating students, their papers, D.D., bank receipt, and payment information are all included in one package. Please keep a copy of the student list with you at all times as it will not be returned you are allowed to use 15% of the funds raised for educational expenses, with the remaining 85% going towards "Rangotsav Celebration".
- Visit our website and select "Payment Gateway" to make an online payment or you can make payments using a QR code, online payment methods, or NEFT only. Please adhere to this policy strictly. The "website" contains information about the Rangotsav Celebration's online payments.
- Awards, Certificates and Momentos will be delivered right to the school.
- You will get bank details in entry form. Cash payment will be not acceptable. All payments should go in Rangotsav Celebration bank account. If any cash transaction is done Rangotsav Celebration is not responsible for that.
- It is mandatory that the competition should be organized only on the school premises. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.
- Art teachers should request Google reviews from the principal or other teachers and upload them to the Rangotsav Celebration website.
- It is up to us to make sure the package has arrived at our location once you courier the submissions. We'll call to let you know as soon as the package is received. When sending a package, please provide a phone number.
- Always follow the final decision of the judge as it is the key to success in complying with the rules and regulations.
- Before sending your parcel, please ensure that payment has been made.
- In case of any query or doubt call us between 10.00 am to 6.00 pm.
